Divine Science is based on the changeless truth that God constitutes the nature of all being and that God fills the invisible and visible realms of existence. This truth has never changed. This truth is as available to man now as it was to Moses, Elijah and Jesus. Nothing man does or fails to do will ever separate him from this Truth. Not only do we “live, move and have our being in the Truth,” “whatsoever God doeth, it shall be forever: nothing can be put to it nor anything taken from it.”

“Where the Spirit of the Lord is, (*in That Mind*) there is freedom.” One of the founders of our teaching writes that “true prayer is not begging for more wisdom, more supply, or more good. Infinite, all embracing Being cannot give us more than Itself. In sharing Itself with us It has given us all that we can possibly need. Our part is to accept.” Healing is not a special act on the part of God, but of man. Dr. Max Ballard, a former minister of the Divine Science Church in Washington, DC, defined the goal of practicing Divine Scientists when he said, “We are not here to demonstrate things, but to know God.”

Divine Science teaches that the fullness of Spirit is forever pouring Itself through the heart of man, limited only by man’s thoughts about life in general and about certain conditions and situations in particular. Therefore, all change begins as an activity in consciousness and manifests as personal experience.

The physical evidence of any teaching lies not in the authority or history of an organization, but in the ability of an individual to prove the teaching. And so it is that Divine Science is recognized as a teaching organization. Therefore, in order to fulfill its *raison d’être*, a course of study in the Principle on which Divine Science is founded is offered through the Divine Science church in Washington, DC. We hope this special Education Issue will be of benefit as you plan your calendar for 2018-2019.

## **Purpose**

The purpose of the Divine Science classes is to awaken the student to his inner potential as a spiritual being. The course of study in Divine Science consists of six classes designed to establish a conscious relationship with God. This study leads to an unfoldment of Law in consciousness.

## **Divine Science Course of Study**

The Divine Science classes are sequentially arranged. The Basic Principle of Divine Science class must be taken first as it is a prerequisite to the other five classes. The Meditation, Spiritual Psychology and Old Testament Bible classes may be taken when the Basic Principle of Divine Science class has been successfully completed. The Old Testament Bible class may be taken only after the Meditation and Spiritual Psychology classes have been successfully completed. The New Testament Bible class may be taken only after the Old Testament Bible class has been completed, and the Higher Training and Consecration class may be taken only after the other five classes have been completed.

Each class is 10 weeks long, tuition is \$65, auditing fee for those repeating the class is \$35.

## **Alumni Association**

The Alumni Association is composed of individuals who have successfully completed the Course of Study in Divine Science. It serves as a supporting arm of the Church by disseminating the Principle of Truth by sponsoring seminars, lectures and special classes. Graduates of the Divine Science classes are regularly invited to lead these presentations.

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### **Basic Principle of Divine Science**

Date: Sunday, September 9, 2018, 9:00 am

*There is no prerequisite to this class. It is open to all.*

The Basic Principle of Divine Science class is the foundation on which all the other classes are built. It is during this class that the student's faith in an ever-present Presence is awakened. Practical Instruction in the application of the teaching is given from the very beginning. This class is offered two times during the church year.

### **Meditation**

*Prerequisite: Basic Principle of Divine Science*

The Meditation class is approached in a well-defined, scientific manner and clearly establishes the difference between the cosmic and spiritual levels of awareness. The transcending spiritual meditation process and its practical application to every-day living are emphasized in every session. Students are encouraged to audit this class often.

### **Bible Mystery and Bible Meaning/Old Testament**

*Prerequisite: Basic Principle of Divine Science*

This class examines the Old Testament in terms of spiritual awareness. When interpreted through consciousness and personal experiences, the hidden meanings of biblical allegories, parables, and symbolic language are revealed. Students discover that the Bible is the story of their own unfoldment which awakens awareness of their divine nature.

### **Bible Mystery and Bible Meaning/New Testament**

*Prerequisite: Basic Principle of Divine Science, Bible Mystery and Bible Meaning/Old Testament*

This class moves the study of the Bible into the New Testament. The class emphasizes the awakening of the Spiritual nature in man as told through the birth of the Christ. This one revelation in the consciousness of an individual transforms ordinary men and women into children of God. In essence, the story of the Bible, when spiritually understood, is the story of man as he moves from the Adam state to the Christ Mind.

### **Higher Training and Consecration**

*Prerequisite: All of the above classes.*

This class stresses the transformation of consciousness from a sense-awareness of life to a Christ-awareness of life. It gently presents to the individual student an opportunity to establish a spiritual basis from which to think and live.
