#### Divine Grace Series



On April 7, 2019, the Alumni Association invited James Tomaski to speak about "Divine Grace." James began his presentation by thanking the Alumni Association for the opportunity to speak today; he said he has always considered the Alumni Association to be a source filled with insight, truth and knowledge. James quoted Psalm 127, "Unless the Lord build the House they labor in vain that build it", and he acknowledges that the "Grace of God" and "Divine Grace" are the same.

James went on to say that in the pass he looked at the "Grace of God" as a means to receive what he wanted in life, but now he seeks God for the sake of God, and upon doing so, he knows that all things will be added onto him.

He also revealed that he had a key interest in reading and studying Ralph Waldo Emerson, the American scholar who went to Rome in the 1830's. He quoted from Emerson's <u>The Universal Outlook</u>, saying the ultimate authority is within yourself, your state of consciousness. Acknowledging that a state of mind centered on God is a power, and a presence over which there is no other power. James reminds us to seek the "Grace of God" through the practice of prayer and meditation, we can teach ourselves to pray, and move into a state of mind that is centered on God through an ongoing practice.

James said he uses RUCATS when he prays. The first step is recognition of the presence of God; the second step is unification; your conscious contact with God. When you create this state of mind it has a powerful effect on life's outcomes, it is the opposite of fear and indecision. Last, we give thanks to God, and avoid outlining how things are to be done, that must be left to the Universal Mind.

#### **BOOKSTORE FINANCIAL REPORT**

Thanks to all of you that purchase your books from the bookstore we continue to make a profit from these sales. We are very grateful for your continued support.

The Profit and Loss (P&L) Statement for the first quarter of the church fiscal year is presented below. The Statement shows a net income of \$381.88. Our total income for the quarter was \$711.73. This amount is made up of \$547.34 in book sales, \$95.39 in tithes, \$20.00 in two new library memberships, \$46.00 for the sale of CDs and \$3.00 for reimbursement of postage and handling.

Our expenses for the same period totaled \$330.15. This amount includes \$294.50 for the purchase of books to stock the bookstore and \$35.65 in postage and handling to mail a book to a foreign country.
