APRIL 7 "HE REMAINS WITH US" Rev. Gene Policastri

The appearance on the road to Emmaus; the appearance on the road to Damascus; the strange man in the graveyard mistaken to be the gardener at first; the strange man cheering on from shore the disciples as they fished; these are all experiences of the Christ following the crucifixion of Jesus.
