JULY 7 "INDEPENDENCE OF SPIRIT"

"Cease ye from man whose breath is in his nostrils: for wherein is he to be accounted of" is the verse from Isaiah. It captures the spiritual principle of being independent from man or materiality. Our dependence should only be on God. Let us call to mind our independence from material things as we celebrate our nation's independence.

JULY 14 "SPIRITUAL HEALING"

The Art of Spiritual Healing is a book by Joel Goldsmith. In that book he discusses the principle of radical reliance on God, not as a servant, but as a cocreator with Man. - 1. It was brought to the attention of the Board that the insurance on the building would not be renewed because the carrier does not insure churches beyond the 50-year mark. Rev. Without insurance, we are not able to have people enter the building with no protection against mishaps.

She graciously made a video and also produced written step by step procedures for maintaining the hybrid service on Sundays.
