JUNE 1 “MAKE YOUR LIFE WORTHWHILE”

In the midst of his troubles, Job reasoned this way: “For He performeth the thing that is appointed for me: and many such things are with Him.” Job 23:14. (King James Bible). At this point Job had been placed on the sidelines of life from what appeared to be nothing other than a cosmic bet between God and Satan. Job lost all. Whereas he was once a wealthy land holder with agricultural assets and an extended family; it was suddenly removed. All of his worldly cares were taken from him; but so was all of his wealth. He had no material means to survive.

Perhaps this is why we are so fearful of taking what used to be known as a summer vacation. Perhaps we fear our livelihood will not be restored when we return to the office after a week or two lounging at the beach. That fear is of course unfounded. And by playing to that fear, we are like Job – fearful of leaving our post lest it be lost. And what happens? World events can cause that loss anyway.
