MARCH 3 "YOUR FAITH HEALS" Rev. Gene Policastri

When Jesus performed his healings, he never took credit. He always gave the credit to the person who received the healing. "Thy faith hath made ye whole." And he also placed the responsibility for healing on the person seeking help. "Wilt thou be made whole?" Faith in the ability to heal our circumstances is always present within us.
