### "BUT WAIT....THERE'S MORE!"

We've likely heard the tag end message that accompanies some advertisements, telling us there are more features to be included if we will just continue to listen. That statement can also be seen as a useful reminder for us in relating to our spiritual practice. As we learn that there is an Invisible Presence behind and within creation we come to know the nature of the "more" that is really available to us.

In our worldly experiences, we easily judge events by worldly standards. We can learn, through practice, to pause and know that all human perception is limited and that there is another dimension to every situation. The reality of each situation is that the Divine is there waiting to be recognized and honored. To pause instead of making any human judgment gives us the opportunity to see and listen beyond just the way things appear. This is our chance to bear witness to the Truth of God's creation knowing that "all things work together for good to them that love God..." Each and every event is an opportunity to know God's Presence regardless of the outer indications.

This ability to pause and resist making human judgments comes to us to the extent that we have practiced turning to Immanuel, God with us and in us. This practice acknowledges the spiritual identity of all being and allows His Presence to go before us, making crooked roads straight. The "work" to see beyond human limitations comes not as an effort but as a revelation. The veils are parted and the Truth of God's creation is revealed. The "more" revealed to those who pause and listen shows what God has already provided. So the phrase, "But wait, there's more" can even be heard as a worldly echo of the call to "Be still and know."

Thank you Father that in Stillness, Omnipresence is made known.
