The month of November is a time for gratitude when we celebrate Thanksgiving. Thanksgiving is a time when our ancestors acknowledged the welcome they received and how the bounty of the land and the Native Americans helped ease the adjustment and transition to the new world. We have carried on the tradition ever since with President Lincoln declaring it a national holiday in 1863 and Congress permanently fixing it as the fourth Thursday of the month in 1941.

Many social organizations devote the whole month of November to expressions of gratitude. And many spiritual practices include maintaining a gratitude journal. In Divine Science gratitude is important. Expressions of gratitude shift the consciousness to acknowledge benefits received, rather than operations from a standpoint of lack. Besides, it is a unifying gesture to acknowledge that we have our material needs met, and we look out at others who may not be so fortunate, and we are compelled to help them meet their needs as well.

Also, gratitude reminds us that we are of a God who has a giving, sharing character. That this is a universe that is designed to meet our needs; that there is abundance all around us just waiting for us to recognize it. We can see the abundance that is there if we look for it. And gratitude helps us not only to look for it but to see it manifest into expression.

The goodness of the Lord is always with us. Let's take time this November to acknowledge it through expressions of gratitude. You can start right way by making a gratitude list of all the things you are grateful for, no matter how seemingly small or trivial. That will get your mindset into the state of seeing all the abundance that exists, and more and more of it will continue to be revealed. List out three things you are grateful for every day from now until the end of the month. And you will see that you will have a whole notebook of evidence of abundance right at your fingertips. Soon you will find that you do not need to create a daily list for expressions and feelings of gratitude will begin to occur spontaneously and automatically.
