Fall 2020 Divine Science Classes

Two of our fall classes start on Sunday, September 13, 2020, at 9:00 am:

<u>Basic Principle of Divine Science</u> Rev. Wayne Gatewood, Instructor

There is no prerequisite for this class. It is open to all.

The Basic Principle of Divine Science class is the foundation on which all the other classes are built. It is during this class that the student's faith in an ever-present Presence is awakened. Practical Instruction in the application of the teaching is given from the very beginning.

<u>Bible Mystery / Bible Meaning New Testament</u> Ms. Sylvia Anderson, Instructor

Prerequisite: Basic Principle of Divine Science

This class examines the New Testament in terms of spiritual awareness. When interpreted through consciousness and personal experiences, the hidden meanings of biblical allegories, parables, and symbolic language are revealed. Students discover that the Bible is the story of their own unfoldment which awakens awareness of their divine nature.

Each class is 10 weeks long, tuition is \$65 and the auditing fee for those repeating the class is \$35. Each class is described in the special Education Issue 2020-2021. Sign-up sheets are on the table in the library.

The warm, or rather hot days of summer will soon come to a close. For most, this has been an unusual summer with many workers in an at home mode and, with students from elementary school to college preparing to engage in a very different kind of school year. We only have a few items to report to you but, nonetheless, they are important.

- We are grateful to the Quimby Memorial Church of Secaucus. New Jersey and Rev. Mary Emma Dryden for their unsolicited gift of \$1,000 to our church. This donation, accompanied with Rev Dryden's statement of belief in the Divine Science teaching was a very welcomed surprise.
- 2. Rev. Wayne Gatewood continues to keep us abreast of the upkeep of the building. This month he submits the following:
 - Outside Foundation Repairs: We have paid the down payment to JES Foundation to begin the outside foundation repairs of the Church, and we are waiting on word regarding a start date.
 - Water in Basement: There was water coming out of the downstairs washroom onto the carpeted hallway. Wayne tore out the drywall and it was discovered that debris was backing



up a boiler pipe. The boiler contractor cleaned out the pipe, and Wayne shall have a contractor install new drywall. Mildew and mold have been treated with breach and mold killer.

- ORKIN Pest Control: ORKIN is doing a good job through its timely and faithful visits to the Church, and we have seen no evidence of a continuing nor growing problem with pests/rodents.
- Church Lighting: Wayne shall be contacting our electrical contractor and having him change a number of florescent and other hard-to-reach lights as required.
- 3. We no longer advertise our church in the Washington Post. During this period of uncertainty, particularly, such an expensive undertaking was not in the best interest of our church budget.
